First I would like to commend your crew for a job VERY well done. You all did an excellent job planning and preparing, prefabbing, and work during the shut down. Every one here was very impressive in there attitude and performance. My expectations were greatly exceeded (and trust me I have very high expectations). Thank you all for a job VERY well done.

Please note that use of a mixture of pipe types (including even using some possible salvaged fittings from our demo if in good enough shape) is ok by me based on what ever gives the best bottom line. Also I think you would use roll grooved not cut grooved pipe if sched 10. Good point on the insulation also. The pumps I believe are scheduled to be shipped next week. Our deadline to meet the needs of the North Tower project, is to have the system up, running and tested by the first of April. Let me know if you have any concerns achieving that schedule.

Could you please give me a trial cost for the T&M work to date. I don't need detail I just need a feel for where we are in the budget. I will need to later discuss before generating actual billing how I may need you to break out some of the costs because there are actually two different projects on our books that will be billed for this. I will be out of town from Wed. noon to through this Friday but I hope we will be able to meet some time next week to begin discussions on the parking garage While Michael and Stan Pehling are in from MSP.
